Main Points

The main points in this report are:

- The estimated population of Scotland on 30 June 2014 was 5,347,600, the highest ever and an increase of 19,900 from the previous year.
- There were approximately 2,596,384 males and 2,751,216 females.
- The population increased because approximately 3,500 more people were born than died, and because in-migration exceeded out-migration by approximately 17,600 between mid-2013 and mid-2014. Other changes, such as in armed forces and prisoners, resulted in a loss of approximately 1,200 people.
- Between mid-2013 and mid-2014, approximately 49,240 people came to Scotland from England, Wales and Northern Ireland, and approximately 39,660 left Scotland to go in the opposite direction, giving a net migration gain of approximately 9,600.
- Compared with the previous year, net migration to Scotland from England, Wales and Northern Ireland has increased by 1,700. This is due to an increase of around 1,560 in the number of people coming to Scotland from the rest of the UK and a decrease of around 160 in the number of people moving in the opposite direction.
- Between mid-2013 and mid-2014, 33,200 people came to Scotland from overseas and 25,200 left Scotland to go overseas giving a net migration gain of 8,000. This represents about 1 in 700 (0.14 per cent) of the total population.
- Compared with the previous year, net migration to Scotland from overseas rose by 5,900. This is primarily because of an increase of 5,000 in the number of people coming to Scotland from overseas, and a decrease of 900 in the number of people moving in the opposite direction.
- Migrants to Scotland tended to be younger than the general population. Of in-migrants to Scotland, 48 per cent from the rest of the UK and 68 per cent from overseas were aged 16-34 years, compared to 25 per cent in the resident population.
- Only seven per cent of people coming to Scotland from the rest of the UK and one per cent of people entering from overseas were aged 65 and over. Scotland had a net gain of UK migrants in every age group and a net loss of international migrants for the majority of migrants aged over 45.
- Among Council areas, between mid-2013 and mid-2014, Midlothian had the largest percentage population increase at +1.8 per cent, followed by Aberdeenshire and Edinburgh City (both +1.1 per cent) and East Renfrewshire (+1.0 per cent). Inverclyde had the largest percentage population decrease at -0.6 per cent, followed by Eilean Siar (-0.5 per cent) and Argyll & Bute (-0.4 per cent).
- Among NHS Board areas, Lothian had the largest percentage population increase (+1.0 per cent), followed by Grampian (+0.9 per cent) and Tayside and Greater Glasgow & Clyde (both +0.4 per cent). Only four NHS Boards experienced a fall in population with Western Isles having the largest decrease at -0.5 per cent, followed by Ayrshire & Arran (-0.3 per cent), Dumfries & Galloway (-0.2 per cent) and Highland (-0.1 per cent).

- The median age of the population in Scotland was 41(the age at which half the population is older and half is younger).
- The median age was lower in big city areas (35 in Glasgow City and 36 in Aberdeen City and the City of Edinburgh) than in more rural Council areas (47 in Argyll & Bute, Dumfries & Galloway, Eilean Siar, Scottish Borders and South Ayrshire).
- On average, in mid-2014 there were 69 people per square kilometre in Scotland, ranging from nine people per square kilometre in Eilean Siar and Highland to 3,433 people per square kilometre in Glasgow City Council area.


1. Background

- 1.1 This paper summarises the National Records of Scotland's (NRS) mid-2014 estimates of the population of Scotland and its administrative areas.
- 1.2 These population estimates are produced using the demographic cohort component method. The estimates are based on the 2011 Census (the results of which are available on the [Scotland's Census](#) website). The population is 'aged on' one year (that is, the 0 year olds become 1 year olds, and so on), the number of births in the year are added, the number of deaths subtracted and adjustments are made for estimated migration and other changes in special populations. It is important to remember that while the number of births and deaths are considered to be almost complete, there is no comprehensive source of migration data for moves within Scotland, or to and from the rest of the UK and the rest of the world. Estimates of migration are made using the best proxy sources available including General Medical Practitioner (GP) registrations and survey information. Therefore, any error in the population estimates is likely to be due to the migration estimates, particularly the international estimates. Other errors can also be introduced from the population base used. The method used to estimate migration is described in [Section 7](#). The methodology behind the population estimates is described in full on the [Mid-Year Population Estimates](#) section of the National Records of Scotland (NRS) website. More information on reconciling mid-year estimates with the latest census results can also be found on the NRS website.
- 1.3 The Scottish Government has set a target to match average European Union (EU15) population growth over the period from 2007 to 2017. The population estimates in this publication will be used to measure progress towards this target. More details can be found on the [Scotland Performs](#) section of the Scottish Government website.
- 1.4 Population estimates are used for a variety of purposes including resource allocation and planning of services such as education and health. They are also used for calculating rates and performance measures, informing local and national policy, weighting surveys and in modelling the economy.
- 1.5 The United Kingdom Statistics Authority (UKSA) designated this publication as National Statistics, in line with the Statistics and Registration Service Act 2007 and signifying compliance with the Code of Practice for Official Statistics in 2011. They are currently reassessing population estimates and a report is due later this year. Further information can be found in the [UK Statistics Authority-Assessments](#) section on the NRS website.
- 1.6 The methodology used to calculate mid-year population estimates is constantly being improved. In consultation with users on the [Population and Migration Statistics Committee](#) (information available on the NRS website), for the mid-2011 estimates onwards we have made improvements to the distributions we apply to international migration estimates and have introduced an adjustment to account for increases in the prison population. More details are found within the updated [methodology paper](#) for mid-year estimates on the NRS website. We have also altered the way we present migration and have made other changes in some of our tables in response to feedback from users.

2. The population of Scotland


Figure 1: Estimated population of Scotland, 1954 to 2014

- 2.1 The latest estimate of Scotland's population (on 30 June 2014) is 5,347,600 – the highest ever and an increase of 19,900 people since 30 June 2013 (Figure 1 below).

- 2.2 The increase in Scotland's population between mid-2013 and mid-2014 has been driven mostly by migration. In the year to mid-2014, in-migration exceeded out-migration by approximately 17,600 people. This included a net gain of around 9,600 people from the rest of the UK and a net gain of around 8,000 from overseas.
- 2.3 Net migration to Scotland from the rest of the UK has increased from approximately 7,900 in the year to mid-2013 to 9,600 in the year to mid-2014. The net gain of 9,600 in the year to mid-2014 came from an inflow of 49,240 (an increase of around 1,560 from the previous year) and an outflow of 39,660 (a decrease of around 160 from the previous year), meaning that the increase in net migration to Scotland from the rest of the UK is being driven by more in-migrants and fewer out-migrants.
- 2.4 Between mid-2013 and mid-2014, 33,200 people came to Scotland from overseas and 25,200 left Scotland to go overseas. The net gain of 8,000 represents about 1 in 700 (0.14 per cent) of the total population. More people came to Scotland from overseas in the year to mid-2014, a net gain of 8,000 compared with 2,100 in the previous year. This is due to 5,000 more migrants arriving in Scotland from overseas (33,200 compared with 28,200 in the previous year), and 900 fewer migrants leaving Scotland to overseas (25,200 compared with 26,100 in the previous year).

- 2.5 Estimating international migration is particularly difficult. The estimates are based on the International Passenger Survey (IPS) which is a sample survey conducted at main airports and ports across the UK. The sample size for Scotland is very small (around 280 contacts between mid-2013 and mid-2014). Internationally, a migrant is defined as someone who changes country of usual residence for 12 months or more, so a short-term seasonal migrant worker will not be counted in the migration estimates or in the mid-year population estimates. More information about the migration data sources and definitions used can be found in [Section 7](#).
- 2.6 Other changes between mid-2013 and mid-2014 (including changes in the prison population, and changes in the number of armed forces stationed in Scotland) resulted in an decrease of approximately 1,200 people.
- 2.7 The number of births in the year to mid-2014 exceeded the number of deaths by approximately 3,500, an increase of 2,600 compared with 900 in the previous year. This increase was driven by approximately 700 fewer births and 3,300 fewer deaths. Most of the decrease in deaths occurred in the first quarter (January to March) and the second quarter (April to June).


Figure 2: Natural change and net migration, 1954 to 2014

- 2.8 Figure 2 shows the trends in natural change (births minus deaths) and net migration. Between the mid-1960s and mid-1970s, both natural change and net out-migration fell dramatically, although the natural change generally remained higher than net out-migration. This resulted in the growth of the population up to 1974. From that point on, through the late 1970s and the 1980s, net out-migration was higher than the natural increase, causing the population to decline. In recent years, Scotland has experienced record levels of net in-migration resulting in small increases in the population in each of the last 14 years.

- 2.9 [Table 8](#) shows movements to and from the UK and overseas between mid-2013 and mid-2014 by age group. The main source of data for the overseas migration

calculations is the International Passenger Survey but, because of its small sample size, an age and sex distribution is estimated using various sources including General Medical Practitioner (GP) registrations. The method used to estimate international migration, including improvements made to the methodology is described in [Section 7](#).

- 2.10 Migrants to Scotland tend to be younger than the general population, as [Table 8](#) shows. Of in-migrants to Scotland, 48 per cent from the rest of the UK and 68 per cent of those from overseas were aged 16-34 years, yet in the resident population only 25 per cent were in this age group. Only seven per cent of people coming to Scotland from the rest of the UK and one per cent of people entering from overseas were aged 65 and over. Scotland had a net gain of UK migrants in every age group and a net loss of international migrants for all age groups over 45.
- 2.11 Figure 3 illustrates the trend in flows of people to and from the rest of the UK and overseas since 1994.
- 2.12 There has been an increase in people coming to Scotland from the rest of the UK in each of the last three years following a general decrease over the previous seven years. A peak of 61,900 was recorded in 2003-2004. There has been very little recent change in outward migration which dropped slightly to 39,700 in 2013-2014 from previous year's figure of 39,800.




- 2.13 In-migration from overseas has been typically increasing since the mid-1990s but dropped over the three-year period from 2010-2011 to 2012-2013, with the largest percentage decrease (21 per cent) recorded in 2012-2013. The latest year, 2013-2014 has seen an increase of 5,000 inward migrants, to 33,200 from last year's 28,200. Out-migration to overseas increased by 55 per cent to 26,200 in 2011-2012 (following drops estimated in three consecutive years from 2008-09) and this level of out-migration was maintained in 2012-2013, with a further small drop in 2013-2014. The figures shown here are from the Long-Term International Migration (LTIM) series produced by the Office for National Statistics (ONS) and the National Records of Scotland rebased international migration estimates for the years ending mid-2002 to mid-2011.

3. The age and sex structure of the population mid-2014


- 3.1 Scotland's estimated population in mid-2014 is shown by age and sex in Figure 4.
- 3.2 The age and sex composition is one of the most important aspects of the population. Changes in different age groups will have different social and economic impacts. For example, increases in the elderly population are likely to place a greater demand on health and social services.

- 3.3 Among older people, particularly those aged over 75, the higher number of females reflects the longer expectation of life for women. Additionally for those aged over 90 this is partly a result of higher rates of male mortality during the Second World War. The two baby booms of 1947 and the 1960s can also be seen with a sharp peak at age 67 and another peak around 50. These baby boomers, along with relatively low fertility rates since the 1960s, are the main reasons why Scotland's population is likely to age in the future.
- 3.4 The changing age structure of the population since 2004 is illustrated in [Figure 5](#). The ageing of the population is evident in the rises in the older age groups (+13 per cent in the 45-59 age group, +17 per cent in the 60-74 age group and +17 per cent in the 75 and over age group) and the falls in some of the younger age groups (-3 per cent in the under 16 age group and -11 per cent in the 30-44 age group).

4. Estimates for administrative areas in Scotland

4.1 Population change between mid-2013 and mid-2014

- 4.1.1 Population estimates for each Council and NHS Board area, together with details of the components of population change (births, deaths, net migration and other changes) for the period mid-2013 to mid-2014, are shown in [Table 4](#).
- 4.1.2 Among Council areas, the largest percentage population increases occurred in Midlothian (+1.8 per cent), Aberdeenshire and Edinburgh City (both +1.1 per cent) and East Renfrewshire (+1.0 per cent).
- 4.1.3 Nine Council areas experienced a decrease in population. The largest percentage decrease occurred in Inverclyde (-0.6 per cent), followed by Eilean Siar (-0.5 per cent) and Argyll & Bute (-0.4 per cent).
- 4.1.4 Of NHS Board areas, Lothian had the largest percentage population increase (+1.0 per cent), followed by Grampian (+0.9 per cent) and Tayside and Greater Glasgow & Clyde (+0.4 per cent). Several NHS Board areas experienced a decline in population with Western Isles having the largest decrease (-0.5 per cent), followed by Ayrshire & Arran (-0.3 per cent) and Dumfries & Galloway (-0.2 per cent).


4.2 Components of migration mid-2013 to mid-2014

- 4.2.1 For most areas, the main cause of population change from mid-2013 to mid-2014 was migration. [Table 5](#) shows migration flows to and from each Council and NHS Board area for people moving within Scotland (i.e. between one Council area and another or between one NHS Board area and another), people moving between Scotland and the rest of the UK and people moving between Scotland and overseas.

4.3 In and out migration

- 4.3.1 As [Figure 6](#) shows, in-migration is greater than out-migration in the majority of Council areas contributing to positive net migration. However, in most areas the difference is not large. Council areas with the largest percentage of in-migrants in their population such as Aberdeen City (6.2 per cent), City of Edinburgh (6.0 per cent) and Stirling (5.6 per cent) also have a comparatively large percentage of out-migrants.
- 4.3.2 In other areas such as Argyll & Bute, Eilean Siar and Inverclyde, the percentage of out-migrants is greater than in-migrants resulting in a net migration loss.

Figure 6: In and out migration from mid-2013 to mid-2014 as a percentage of population by Council area (ranked by increasing proportion of in-migrants)¹



4.3.3 As [Figure 7a](#) shows, different Council areas attract migrants from different areas. In all but three Council areas (namely the City of Edinburgh and Dumfries & Galloway and Glasgow City), most of the migrants came from other Council areas within Scotland. For example, of the 4,045 people estimated to have arrived in East Dunbartonshire, 3,485 (about 86 per cent) were from elsewhere in Scotland, 455 (about 11 per cent) were from the rest of the UK and 105 (about three per cent) were from overseas. Over half of in-migrants to Dumfries and Galloway were from the rest of the UK.


■ Within Scotland ■ Rest of UK* ■ Overseas**

4.3.4 In the City of Edinburgh and Dumfries & Galloway more than half of the in-migrants came from outside Scotland with most of these coming from the rest of the UK.

4.3.5 The number of in-migrants from overseas exceeded the number of in-migrants from the rest of the UK in only two Council areas, Aberdeen City and Glasgow City.

4.3.6 As [Figure 7b](#) shows, there are also differences in the destinations of people migrating out of Council areas. Often the region to which most out-migrants moved was the same region from which most in-migrants had arrived. For example most of the migrants leaving East Dunbartonshire, East Renfrewshire and Midlothian moved elsewhere in Scotland and, as already described, most of the migrants arriving in these Council areas came from elsewhere in Scotland. Similarly, around half of the migrants leaving the City of Edinburgh and Dumfries & Galloway moved outwith Scotland, with most of them moving to the rest of the UK.

■ Within Scotland □ Rest of UK* ▨ Overseas**


4.4 Net migration

- 4.4.1 As [Table 5](#) shows, some Council areas experienced net gains from one region but net losses to another.
- 4.4.2 Several Council areas experienced net gains of people from all regions (within Scotland, the rest of the UK and overseas), these are Aberdeenshire, Angus, East Lothian, Falkirk, Perth & Kinross and West Lothian.
- 4.4.3 The city authorities tended to lose migrants to other areas of Scotland but gain from the rest of the UK and overseas. For example, there was a net gain of 3,328 migrants in the City of Edinburgh - comprising net losses of 1,705 people to the rest of Scotland and net gains of 1,766 and 3,267 people from the rest of the UK and overseas, respectively.

4.5 Age and sex structure of administrative areas in Scotland

- 4.5.1 There were more women than men in Scotland in mid-2014. This was the case for all Council areas other than Shetland Islands and for all NHS Board areas other than Shetland. [Table 7](#) shows the sex ratio for each Council and NHS Board area in Scotland for mid-2014. The sex ratio is the male population divided by the female population (e.g. a sex ratio of 0.95 means that for every 100 females there are 95 males). The sex ratio ranged from 0.91 in North Ayrshire to 1.03 in Shetland Islands. For the NHS Board areas, the sex ratio ranged from 0.92 in Ayrshire & Arran to 1.03 in Shetland. Figure 8 shows how the sex ratio varies for Council areas across Scotland.
- 4.5.2 The main reason for there being more women than men in Scotland is due to the longer life expectancy of women. Other reasons for differences in the proportions of men and women in areas of Scotland may relate to migration and employment, for example in areas with armed forces bases or oil industry work.

Figure 8: Proportion of males and females by Council area, mid-2014





4.5.3 Although the pattern of age distribution is complex, some general themes can be found in [Table 7](#). Most city Council areas had a high proportion of men and women of working age. For example, in Aberdeen City 72 per cent of men and 66 per cent of women were of working age compared with 66 per cent of men and 61 per cent of women for all of Scotland. The highest proportions of people of state pension age tended to be in more rural Council areas such as Argyll & Bute (22 per cent of men and 31 per cent of women) and Dumfries & Galloway (23 per cent of men and 29 per cent of women). In Scotland as a whole, 16 per cent of men and 23 per cent of women were of pensionable age¹.


Figure 9: Age structure of Council areas, mid-2014 (ranked by percentage aged 65+)

4.5.4 These patterns can also be found in [Figure 9](#) and [Figure 10](#) which show the proportion of the population aged under 16, 16-64, and 65 and over for Council and NHS Board areas respectively (ranked by the proportion of the population aged 65 and over).

4.6 Population density mid-2014

4.6.1 Land areas and population densities for mid-2014 are shown in [Table 9](#). The mid-2014 population density for Scotland was 69 people per square kilometre and ranged from nine people per square kilometre in Eilean Siar to 3,433 people per square kilometre in Glasgow City. For comparison, the average population density for the UK at mid-2013² was 264 people per square kilometre. Land areas used for calculating population densities are based on the latest Standard Area Measurements produced by the Office for National Statistics.

4.6.2 [Figure 11a](#) and [Figure 11b](#) provide information on population densities for mid-2014.

Figure 11a: Population density by Council area, mid-2014





Figure 11b: Population density by Council area, mid-2014



5. Components of population change for administrative areas in Scotland, mid-2004 to mid-2014

- 5.1 Since mid-2004 Scotland's population has increased by 5.2 per cent. In most Council areas the population has increased as shown by the map in [Figure 12a](#) and chart in [Figure 12b](#). The largest percentage increases have occurred in Aberdeenshire (+11.0 per cent), East Lothian (+10.7 per cent) and Edinburgh City (+10.5 per cent). However, in some Council areas, such as Inverclyde (-3.4 per cent), Argyll & Bute (-3.2 per cent) and West Dunbartonshire (-2.4 per cent), the population has decreased. The population has increased in all NHS Board areas as shown by [Figure 13](#).
- 5.2 The relative importance of migration and natural change differs between Council areas. For ease of presentation other changes have been included with migration for the analysis in this section. In some areas where the population has increased since mid-2004, such as North Lanarkshire, Shetland Islands and West Lothian, the gain is attributable to both migration and natural increase (more births than deaths). East Lothian, Stirling and Dundee City have experienced a population increase because of in-migration combined with a relatively low (positive) natural change. In other areas, the population increase is due to in-migration, despite the number of deaths exceeding the number of births. These areas included Eilean Siar, Angus and Perth & Kinross.
- 5.3 Inverclyde and West Dunbartonshire have experienced population decreases both from migration and natural change, whereas in Argyll & Bute the population decline is mainly attributable to more deaths than births. Figure 12a: Percentage change in population, Council areas, mid-2004 to mid-2014




Figure 12b: Percentage change in population, Council areas, mid-2004 to mid-2014





Figure 13: Percentage change in population, NHS Board areas*, mid-2004 to mid-2014

7. Notes and definitions

Population covered

The estimated population of an area includes all those usually resident there, whatever their nationality. Students are treated as being resident at their term-time address. Members of UK and non-UK armed forces stationed in Scotland are included; UK forces stationed outside Scotland are excluded. Short-term international migrants, who stay for less than 12 months, are excluded.

Age

Population figures relate to 30 June of the year shown and ages relate to age at last birthday.

Presentation of estimates

Although the populations are tabulated in units, this does not imply accuracy to that level. The data are presented in units for the convenience of users wishing to compile non-standard aggregations without encountering rounding problems.

Administrative areas

The composition of the NHS Board areas in terms of Council areas is summarised in the table below. Boundary changes, effective from 1 April 2014, mean that the boundaries for all 14 NHS Board areas are now aligned with Council area boundaries. In most NHS Board areas the impact of the boundary changes on the population estimates are small. However, NHS Greater Glasgow & Clyde and NHS Lanarkshire are exceptions. Based on unpublished National Records of Scotland mid-2012 population estimates, had the boundary changes taken effect on the 30 June 2012 NHS Greater Glasgow would have lost approximately 6.5 per cent of its population to NHS Lanarkshire and NHS Lanarkshire would have lost 0.3 per cent of its population to NHS Greater Glasgow & Clyde. The tables presented in this report show information for the new NHS Board areas for all years.

Land area

The land areas used to calculate the population density information presented in Table 9 were derived from the latest Standard Area Measurements produced by the Office for National Statistics.

Methodology and comparisons across the UK

The National Records of Scotland (NRS) website has a guide that describes the [methodology](#) used to produce the mid-year population estimates for Scotland. This methodology is similar to that used to produce population estimates in other UK countries. A [comparison of data sources and methods](#) (Portable Document Format (PDF) 157 Kb) used for population estimates across the UK is available from the Office for National Statistics (ONS) website.

Sources of migration data

Migration is the most difficult component of population change to estimate, as there is no comprehensive system which registers migration in the UK, either moves to or from the rest of the world, or moves within the UK. Estimates of migration have therefore to be based on survey data and the best proxy data that exist.

Migration estimates are derived from the following key sources of data. The National Health Service Central Register (NHSCR) is used to calculate moves between NHS Board areas within the UK, with migration at Council area and below estimated using anonymised data from the Community Health Index (CHI) supplied with the permission of the Scottish Directors of Public Health. The International Passenger Survey (IPS) provides information on moves into and out of Scotland with an origin or destination of outside the UK. In addition to IPS data, additional information is used for asylum seekers. These three main sources are described in more detail in the remainder of this section.

More information on the methodology used to estimate migration can be found in the [Migration Methodology](#) section and in the [Mid-Year Population Estimates for Scotland Methodology Guide](#) on the NRS website.

Internal migration within the UK

The NHSCR system records the movements of patients between NHS Board areas in the UK. Each time a patient transfers to a new NHS doctor in a different NHS Board area, the NHSCR is notified and the patient is then considered to have made a migrant move. Counts of these re-registrations are used as a proxy indicator for moves within the UK.

The CHI holds records of people registered with an NHS doctor in Scotland. The records used in production of the mid-year population estimates contain the postcode of the patient's address, which enables migration to be estimated for Council areas, and for smaller areas. The approach used for estimating Council area-level migration involves matching CHI patient records extracted from a database which reflects the 'live' CHI system on two occasions one year apart.

Currently, migration data derived from the NHSCR is considered to be the most reliable data available at NHS Board level, so estimates from the CHI are controlled to ensure that they are consistent with the NHSCR data for moves across a NHS Board boundary by origin, destination, age and sex.

Due to an improvement in data sources, the accuracy of cross border migration data between Scotland and Northern Ireland was improved from mid-2009. More information on the nature of the improvements is contained in the papers from the May 2010 meeting of the [Population and Migration Statistics Committee \(PAMS\)](#), available on the NRS website. We are continuing to review the process for

estimating internal migration, including investigating the use of patients' postcode information held on the NHSCR. More information on the progress of this work can be found in papers of the [Population and Migration Statistics Committee \(PAMS\)](#).

International migration

An international migrant is defined by the United Nations (UN) as someone who changes country of residence for 12 months or more. There is no single, all-inclusive system in place to measure all movements of population into and out of the UK or to determine if they meet the definition of a long term migrant. Therefore, it is necessary to use a combination of data from different sources that have different characteristics and attributes in order to produce estimates of international migration. While offering the best data currently available, none of the data sources used is specifically designed to capture information solely on international migration.

National Records of Scotland (NRS) use the Long-Term International Migration (LTIM) estimates (previously referred to as Total International Migration (TIM)) produced by Office for National Statistics (ONS) for the national estimates of international migration to and from Scotland. These are the best estimates of the moves to and from the UK that meet the definition of long term migration.

Three sources of data are used by ONS to compile the LTIM estimates for Scotland:

- The International Passenger Survey (IPS) is a continuous sample survey conducted by ONS at the principal air, sea and Channel Tunnel routes between the United Kingdom (UK) and countries outside the British Isles. It is the prime source of migration data to and from the UK, providing estimates of both inflows and outflows, but does not cover all migration types;
- Home Office (HO), which provides data on asylum seekers and their dependants;
- The Labour Force Survey (LFS), which collects information on where international migrants live.

Fundamental changes were introduced to the IPS sample design at the beginning of 2009 to make the survey more focused on identifying migrants. These changes included a re-organisation of the times and frequency of sampling of travellers, sampling at additional locations including Aberdeen and improvements to the IPS weighting methodology.

Given that the IPS collects information on intentions which may or may not be realised, an adjustment is made to the IPS data for visitor and migrant switchers (people who change their intentions and their migratory status).

The IPS provides an estimate of international migrants into the UK. The allocation of these migrants to Scotland is based on the LFS. The LFS provides more reliable data on the geographical distribution of immigrants than the destination provided in the IPS as it is based on where migrants actually live rather than on their initial intentions. The outflow of international migrants from Scotland is based directly on the IPS data. More information on the [LTIM method](#) including the quality of the IPS can be found on the ONS website.

Comparison of country of birth data from the 2001 Census, the 2011 Census and LTIM estimates of international migration to Scotland from mid-2001 to mid-2011 indicated that much of the 45,100 difference between the 2011 Census and 2001 Census based mid-2011 population estimates was because of an underestimation of international migration to Scotland across the decade. Scotland's international migration time series has been revised for mid-2002 to mid-2011 to reflect this. For more details go to [Methods used to revise population estimates for Scotland and its administrative areas for mid-2002 to mid-2010](#) within the Mid-2002 to Mid-2010 Revision section on the NRS website.

Distribution of international migrants to areas within Scotland

International migration flows between Scotland and overseas are allocated to each NHS Board area and given an assumed age and sex distribution using proportions recorded on the NHS Central Register (NHSCR). These proportions are applied to the total LTIM flows for Scotland. In consultation with users, for the 2011 Census based mid-2011 population estimates onwards (and the rebased mid-year population estimates for 2002 to 2010) we have used a new methodology to distribute international migrants to NHS Board areas. For more details go to Paper 5 PAMS 13 (05) from the April 2013 meeting of the [Population and Migration Statistics Committee](#) which is available on the NRS website.

For inflows the recorded moves from overseas to Scottish NHS Boards on the NHSCR are used to estimate the proportion of migrants entering each area. NHSCR records hold limited data on international outflows from NHS Boards to overseas, as patients do not reliably de-register with their doctor when moving overseas. International outflows are currently allocated to NHS Board areas based on flows of other groups of migrants which stand as a proxy for overseas out-migrants.

Age and sex distributions of international migrants are obtained from the NHSCR in a similar way, and calculated separately for each NHS Board, with proxy groups again providing the characteristics of out-migrants.

It is acknowledged that NHSCR flows undercount the number of migratory moves, for young men in particular, due to General Medical Practitioner (GP) registration behaviour in different groups. Compared with LTIM estimates by sex there are fewer men in both the in and out-migrant groups recorded on the NHSCR. A sex-ratio adjustment has been introduced from 2011 which increases the number of male migrants at young adult ages where there is a large majority of women seen in the NHSCR data.

The distribution of migrants to Council areas is based on records from the Community Health Index (CHI), which are made consistent with the NHSCR geographic and age/sex distributions. International in-migrants were allocated using records appearing on the CHI extract where the patient had arrived from overseas. Like the NHSCR, the CHI extract holds limited data on people leaving Scotland for overseas and so international out-migrants were allocated using a combination of in-migrants to Scotland from overseas and migrants leaving Scotland for the rest of the UK.

Work to improve the method used to allocate international out-migrants to NHS Board and Council areas is continuing and further improvements will be considered for future publications.

NRS has data access agreements with the suppliers of the NHS Central Register (NHSCR) and Community Health Index (CHI) data that we use to produce mid-year population estimates. We are in regular contact with both suppliers and we are informed of any data quality issues that may impact upon the mid-year population estimates. Likewise, we quality assure the data we receive and communicate back any issues that arise.

For example, we were informed of data cleaning work that had taken place on the NHSCR between October 2012 and February 2013, and were able to establish that this was having the effect of artificially increasing the apparent number of migrants who arrived in Scotland from the rest of the UK. To allow for this, we made an adjustment to the NHSCR data to exclude the records included in the data as a result of the data cleaning exercise.

Research into improving migration and population statistics

Since the early 2000s, and especially since Eastern European countries joined the European Union (EU) in May 2004, migration has played a larger part in Scotland's demographic change than in the previous decade. So it has become more important to have high quality statistics on migration and the population, for policy development and for planning and providing public services. National Records of Scotland was part of an inter-departmental effort, led by the Office for National Statistics (ONS), to improve the estimates of migration and migrant populations in the UK, both nationally and at a local level. Although the programme has now finished, work to improve migration statistics is continuing. In Scotland the key focus is on reconciling the mid-year estimates with the [2011 Census results](#) (available on Scotland's Census website). The mid-year population estimates for 2002 to 2010 have been rebased to better reflect these results.

As a result of the latter report we reviewed our method for distributing international migrants; affecting local areas and the age and sex profile.

We are currently comparing 2011 Census data on migration within Scotland with NHSCR flows and will report on this work later in 2015. As mentioned earlier, we are improving how we use the NHSCR data making use of a record level extract. More details are available in the papers of the [Population and Migration Statistics Committee \(PAMS\)](#) available on the NRS website.

We are also looking at the potential for incorporating new data sources, for example student data from Higher Education Statistics Authority, or Council Tax data, to improve our estimates.

Publication of future population estimates

Mid-year population estimates for 2015 will be published in Spring 2016.
