## **Information requested:**

Information relating to ground subsistence and building damage, particulairly relevant photographs and records/measurements of ground and building movements, which occurred in the Hopetoun Street area of Bathgate in the period 1975-76.

## NRS Response:

While our aim is to provide information whenever possible, in this instance National Records of Scotland does not have the information requested.
