Access for sight of the decision made by Lord Patrick on the 5 February 1946 in connection with the Court of Session case Prestwick Cinema Co Ltd v James C Gardiner (CS258/26521).

Please find below an accurate transcription from the Interlocutor sheets of the Court of Session papers, in the action Prestwick Cinema Co Ltd v James C Gardiner (NRS Ref.: CS258/26521):

5th February 1946 Lord Patrick Act. Cameron K.C.A et. Shewan Alt. Morrison K.C.A Shaw C.J.D

The Lord Ordinary having considered the cause finds that the defender is entitled to have his business described as that of "Baker and Confectioner" in the disposition to be granted by the Defender in implement of the missives of Sale of the subjects known as Albert Cottage, 82 Main Street, Prestwick: Repels the sixth plea-in-law for the pursuers: and decerns: Finds the pursuers jointly and severally liable to the defender in expenses, in so far as not already dealt with, and remits the account thereof to the Auditor to tax and to report.
