A sensitivity review has been undertaken on this material by the Scottish Courts and Tribunals Service (SCTS). As a result of this, some information in the files has been redacted due to sensitivity issues. SCTS were able to review and release personal information relating to the defendant once they had confirmation he was deceased.

An exemption under section 38(1)(b) of FOISA (personal information) has been applied to all three files. Some of the information contained in these files has been redacted because it is personal data of a third party and disclosing it would contravene the General Data Protection Regulation and Data Protection Act 2018. This exemption is not subject to the 'public interest test', so we are not required to consider if the public interest in disclosing the information outweighs the public interest in applying the exemption.
