## **NRS Response:**

A sensitivity review has been undertaken on this file by the Scottish Prisons Service (SPS). SPS have decided to make the register publicly accessible for the years 1888 to 1939 inclusive. This has been implemented with the theory that all patients were aged 21 or over on the date of their admission.
