Request for information relating to a divorce record (CS258/1972/4062).

NRS Response:

A sensitivity review has been undertaken on this material by the Scottish Courts and Tribunals Service (SCTS). As a result of this, some information in the files has been redacted due to sensitivity issues.

Extensive personal information is disclosed in the file relating to people involved in the case and as a statutory death certificate could not be traced for them, they are presumed to be still alive. An exemption under section 38(1)(b) of FOISA applies to this information because it is personal data of third parties and disclosing it would contravene the data protection principles in Article 5(1) of the General Data Protection Regulation and in section 34(1) of the Data Protection Act 2018. This information has thus been redacted. This exemption is not subject to the 'public interest test', so we are not required to consider if the public interest in disclosing the information outweighs the public interest in applying the exemption.

In addition, some of the information contained in the file relates to the applicant. This information is exempt under section 38(1)(a) of FOISA (personal information of which the applicant is the data subject) and has thus also been redacted.

Should you wish to access the information relating to you contained in this file, you have the option of submitting a Subject Access Request directly to the data controller, SCTS.
