

## ADDITIONAL INFORMATION TO ACCOMPANY MARRIAGE NOTICE APPLICATION FORMS (M10)

### CELEBRANT DETAILS

If you are having a religious or belief marriage ceremony, please ask your celebrant to confirm what they normally sign, as this signature will be transcribed by the registrar from the Marriage Schedule (which will be signed on the day of the wedding) into the legal record of your marriage (the marriage register). It will also appear on your marriage extract.

**EXAMPLE:**

James Richardson Marr may sign James Marr, James R Marr, J R Marr or Jim Marr. The registrar must know what a signature says in order to transcribe it correctly.

### WITNESS DETAILS

By law, you must have two witnesses present at your wedding who are 16 years of age or over, and capable of understanding the marriage ceremony. Please enter below the full names, addresses and confirmation of the usual signatures of the witnesses to your wedding.
