

Appendix 4:**Royal Navy and Royal Marines War Deaths - Codes for Cause of Death**

- 1 Killed in action
 - Died of wounds or disease following wounds
 - Missing after action and subsequently presumed killed in action
 - Killed
 - Died of wounds or exposure
 - Died of disease following wounds or exposure
 - Drowned
 - Missing and subsequently presumed killed or drowned following loss of ship in action, by mine or torpedo.
- 2 Killed
 - Died of injuries or exposure
 - Died of disease following injuries or exposure
 - Drowned
 - Missing and subsequently presumed killed or drowned following the accidental loss of a ship (wreck, collision, internal explosion, etc.) or where the actual cause of a vessel's loss is not known
 - Accidental deaths (killed, drowned, etc.)
 - Deaths due to injuries or disease following injuries accidentally sustained.
- 3 Deaths from disease
- 4 Deaths due to suicide, murder, alcoholism, heat-stroke
 - Deaths under anaesthetic and any cases which cannot be classified under disease or accident.
