2) Many of the deaths which are counted against this heading in the latest quarter are ones for which National Records of Scotland (NRS) has yet to receive further information that will enable it to classify them properly. So the final number of deaths for this quarter for this category is expected to be much smaller than the current figure.

3) These categories' final numbers for the latest quarter will be much larger. This is because NRS expects to receive further information about most of the deaths that are currently counted under 'R96-99 Other ill-defined and unknown causes', which will result in them being classified to these categories.
