Terms of reference and membership

Introduction

This paper summarises the current remit, working arrangements and membership of the Household Analysis Review Group (HARG).

Since the last meeting in November 2016 there have been a number of developments in NRS household statistics as well as changes to the Group's membership. So this seems an appropriate time to confirm whether the purpose and membership of the Group is still appropriate, and how it should best carry out its business.

Purpose and remit

The group will be concerned with the household estimates and projections produced by the National Records of Scotland (NRS). Its overall purpose is to assist NRS to:

- a) maintain relevant good quality official household estimates and projections;
- b) develop small area household estimates;
- c) provide users with sound advice on the basis of household estimates and projections and their use.

To achieve its purpose, HARG will review and advise NRS on:

- a) the need for and uses made of the NRS household estimates and projections;
- b) the data sources used to compile estimates and projections and possible alternatives;
- c) the methodologies used to compile estimates and projections and possible alternatives;
- d) the approaches used to consult/ inform all users on methodological and data issues.

Membership

Since the last meeting of HARG in November 2016, a number of people (not least from NRS) have stood down from its membership, e.g. through retirement or moving to new jobs. We have recently attempted to refresh the membership list – see Annex A for the current version – but would be interested in any suggestions for additional members.

Reporting Arrangements

HARG reports to the Population and Migration Statistics (PAMS) committee. It also previously linked in to the Scotstat consultation framework through the Built Environment Statistics Advisory Committee (BESAC). However, BESAC has not met in a number of years as consultation with users

is now more focussed on individual projects such as the Scottish Household Survey Questionnaire Review and one-off user events such as the Private Rented Sector event on 26 June.

Frequency of Meetings

It is proposed that most of the business of the HARG be carried out by correspondence, but that it should meet in person at least once a year with more frequent meetings as necessary, eg to discuss one-off issues.

Summary

Members of the Group are asked to comment on the current purpose, remit and membership of HARG, and on the proposed working arrangements going forward.
