## Dissemination and 2001 Census analysis update

### 1. Introduction

The purpose of this paper is to inform members of the Population and Migration Statistics (PAMS) committee about recent developments in dissemination and 2001 Census analysis at the General Register Office for Scotland (GROS). It gives an update on progress since the last meeting of the committee (13<sup>th</sup> October 2010) as well as an outline of future plans.

### 2. Progress since last meeting

2.2.3 A [Census Equality Impact Assessment paper](#), which details the work being done to make the census more accessible to groups impacted by equality issues, was added to the Census section of the website.

There is also a '[Statistics by Theme](#)' section, which gives more detailed information about each of the demographic topics.
