

## Population and Migration Statistics Committee (PAMS) (Scotland)

### 1. Introduction

- 1.1 The purpose of this paper is to inform members of the Population and Migration Statistics (PAMS) committee about recent developments in the Statistical Information Services branch at the National Records of Scotland (NRS). It gives an update on progress since the last meeting of the committee (28 March 2012) as well as an outline of future plans.
- 1.2 Donna Hosie will be leaving NRS on 5 October 2012 and will be replaced by Alan Sloan, who is currently working in Alternative Sources branch and has also been involved in downstream processing work in Census division.

### 2. Progress since last meeting

- 2.1 The Customer Services team have been doing preparatory work on table production for the standard outputs from the 2011 Census, which they will continue to do until the tables are published next year.
