Deaths involving Covid-19 rose in the last month

As of 12th September 2021, 10,688 deaths involving Covid-19 have been registered.

Deaths where Covid-19 was mentioned were above 40 each week for the last 9 consecutive weeks.

Younger people dying with Covid-19 are more likely to have no pre-existing conditions

In the 65+ age group, 6% of people dying with COVID-19 had no pre-existing conditions. This was the same for both males and females.


Among the under 65s, 12% of females and 15% of males who died with COVID-19 had no pre-existing conditions.

Excess deaths have been above average for 16 consecutive weeks

As of 12th September, deaths are 7% higher than average in 2021. There were 103 excess deaths registered in week 36.


Most of these excess deaths occured at home or in a non-institutional setting. Deaths in these settings have been above average in every week of 2021.

Deaths involving Covid-19




Pre-existing conditions of deaths involving Covid-19
