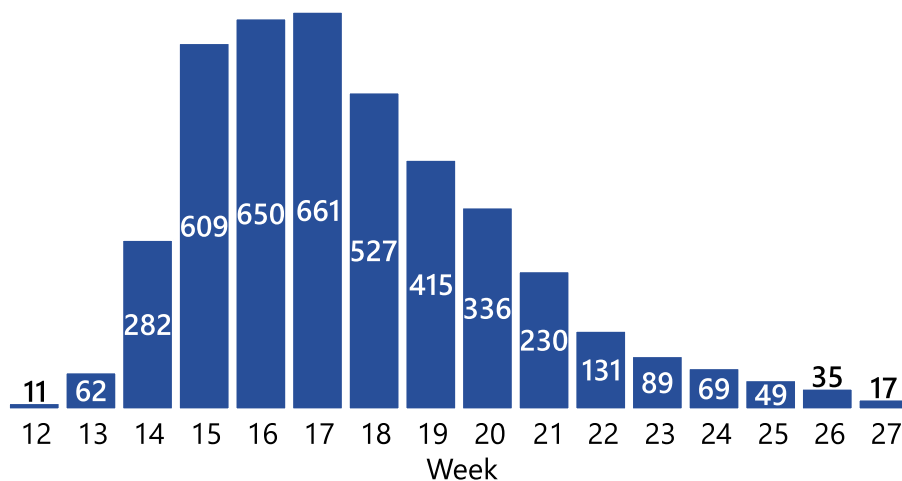


As of 5th July, 4,173 deaths had been registered which mentioned COVID-19

The highest number of COVID-19 deaths were registered in week 17 (20th to 26th April). Deaths have decreased weekly since then to reach a level of 17 in week 27.

Most excess deaths have occurred in care homes

Between weeks 12 and 27 (16th March to 5th July) there were 2,412 (62%) more deaths in care homes than average. COVID-19 was the underlying cause in 1,867 (77%) of these excess deaths.

In the same period, there were 2,527 excess deaths which took place at home or in a non-institutional setting (55% above average). COVID-19 was the underlying cause in 239 (9%) of these excess deaths.

After peaking in week 15, hospital deaths fell below average levels in week 19 and are now 72 (<1%) below average levels for the full period.
