2 Data zone figures are not available on occupied dwellings, vacant dwellings and dwellings with 'occupied exemptions' in East Renfrewshire. These data zones have been removed from calculations for each SIMD decile. The Scotland figure includes the East Renfrewshire total, from Table 9, to be in line with other Scotland-level statistics quoted in the publication.
