Methodology:

The migration estimates are those associated with the mid-year population estimates for 2006-latest.

Moves between Scotland and overseas are estimated using the Long Term International Migration (LTIM) estimate which is mainly based on the International Passenger Survey (IPS). These are then distributed amongst administrative areas using a combination of the National Health Service Central Register (NHSCR) and the Community Health Index (CHI).

The table also shows moves to and from other areas within Scotland and to and from the rest of the UK.

These are derived from a combination of the National Health Service Central Register (NHSCR) and Community Health Index (CHI).

For more information on how population and migration estimates are produced go to the methodology sections within the migration and population areas of the NRS website. Some commentary can be found in the mid-year estimates and the Annual Review of Demographic Trends publications for the relevant years.

Note:

The mid-year population estimates and migration estimates for 2002 to 2010 are scheduled for revision following the 2011 Census and are to be published in December 2013.
