## Methodology:

The migration estimates are those associated with the mid-year population estimates for 1996-latest.

They are taken from the National Health Service Central Register (NHSCR).

It is assumed that migrants take an average of 3 months to register with a new GP and so the data covers registrations between October and September which are assumed to relate to moves between July and June.

From 1 April 2006 responsibility for NHS Argyll & Clyde was split between NHS Greater Glasgow (now known as Greater Glasgow and Clyde) and NHS Highland.

The tables on the NRS website generally show the old NHS Board areas. This is because it is often not possible to create the same data for the new NHS Board areas using the available data.

For more information on how population and migration estimates are produced go to the methodology sections within the migration and population areas of the NRS website. Some commentary can be found in the mid-year estimates and the Annual Review of Demographic Trends publications for the relevant years.

### Note:

The mid-year population estimates and migration estimates for 2002 to 2010 are scheduled for revision following the 2011 Census and are to be published in December 2013.
