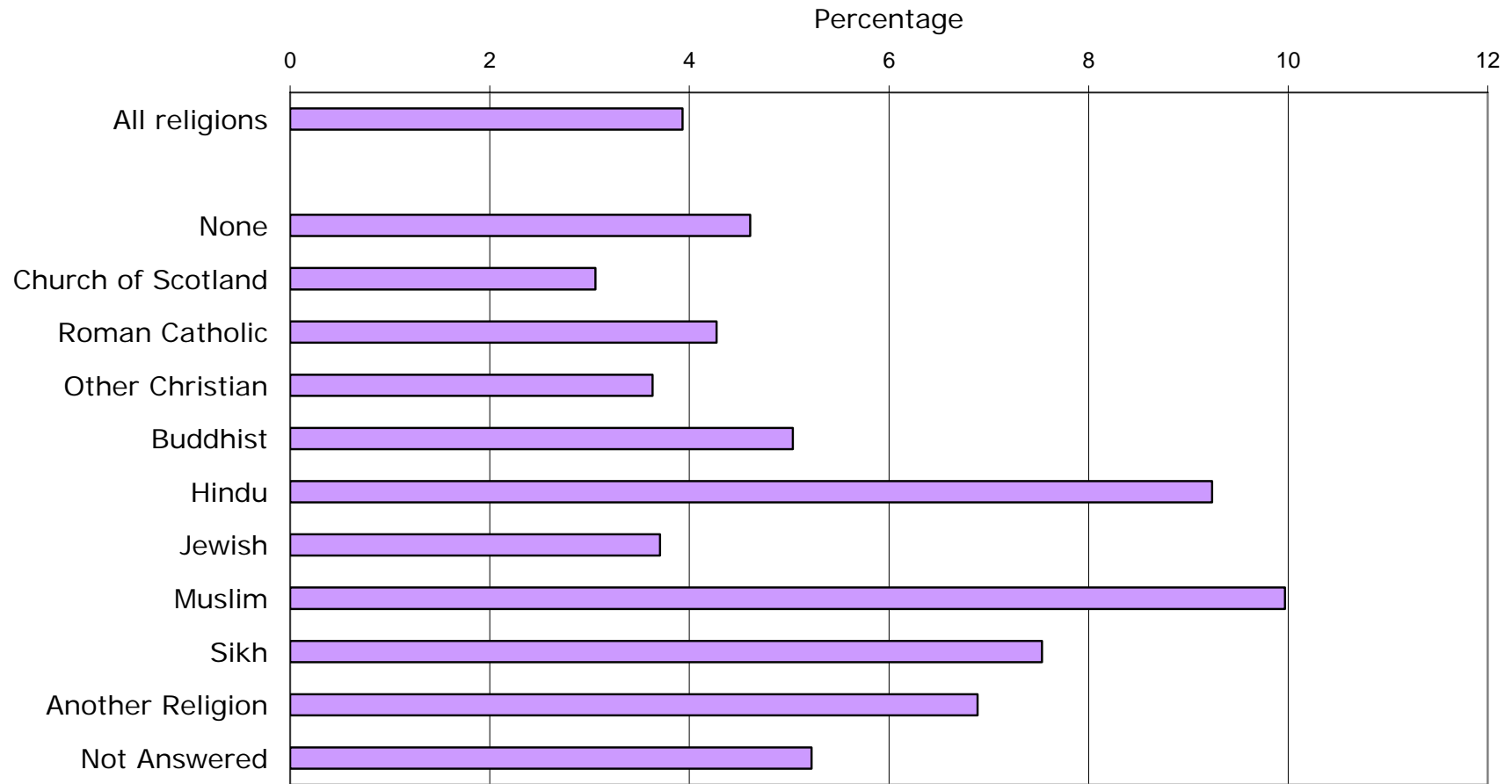

Because the questions on religion were voluntary, it was considered inappropriate to impute a value when the form-filler hadn't supplied one. These cases were left as 'Not Answered'.

Nevertheless, since the purpose of the ONC process was to remove a bias in distributions caused by under-enumeration, it was decided that the value of current religion in the donor record would, as for other variables, be inserted into the records added. Some 3.9 percent of person records were added by the ONC. This rate varied across religions, with high values in Hindu (9.2 percent) and Muslim (10.0 percent).
