For a small percentage of cases (0.03 percent), a person's recorded sex was changed during scrutiny of records of couples recorded as being of the same sex. In some cases, according to the first names entered, it was judged that the wrong sex had been ticked for one of the couple.

A missing value was imputed for around 0.3 percent of cases with very similar rates for males and females.

Around 3.9 percent of persons were added by the ONC process with the rate for males around 1 percentage point higher than the rate for females.
