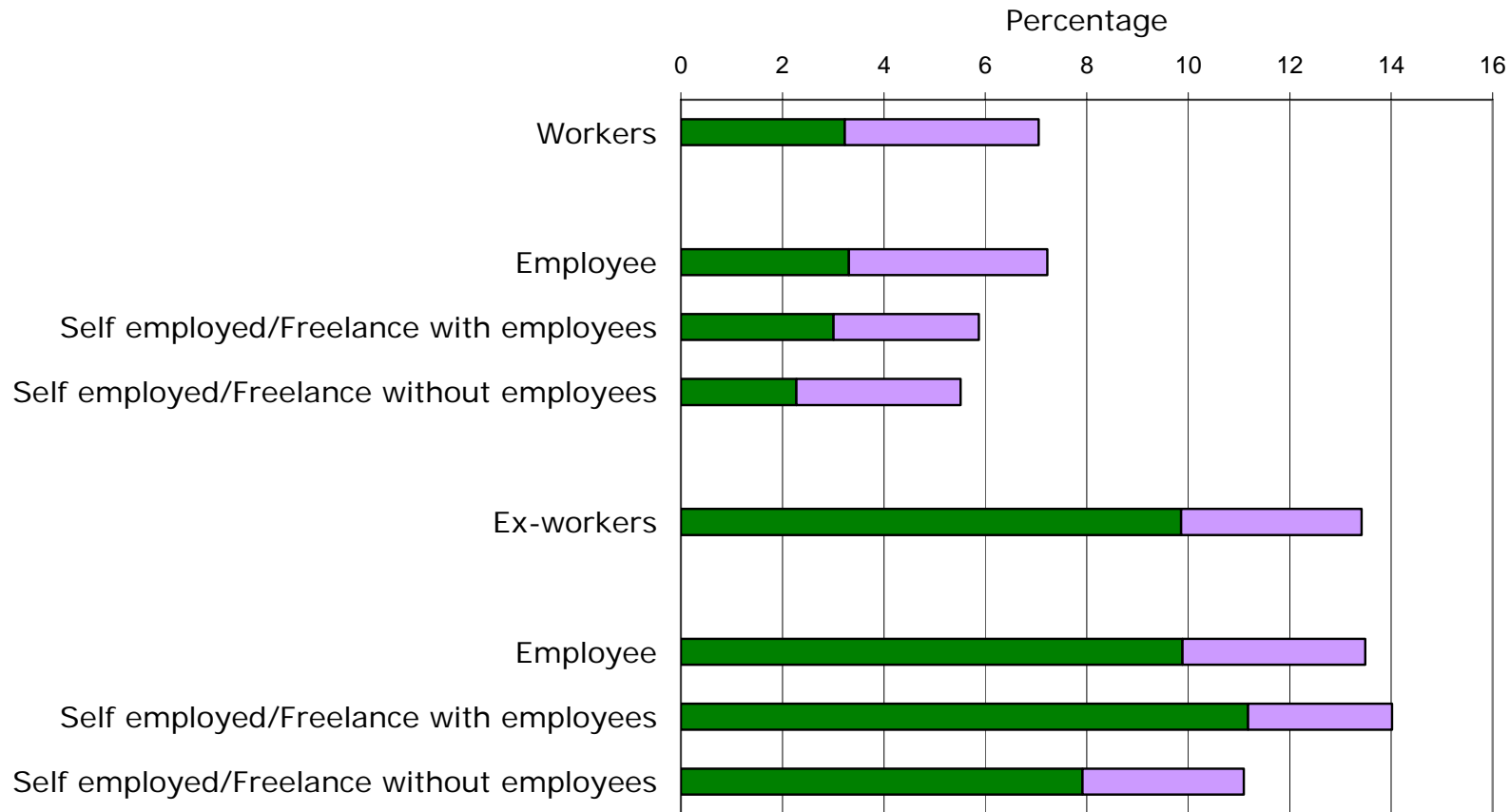

A value for Employment status was imputed when none supplied on the form in 3.2 per cent of workers (ie in employment) but 9.9 percent for 'ex-workers' (ie persons aged 16-74 not working but with previous employment). The highest rate of imputation was for ex-workers who were self employed or Freelance with employees.

A more even rate of imputation was seen for persons added by the ONC process, with 3.8 and 3.6 percent respectively of workers and ex-workers accounted for by the ONC.
