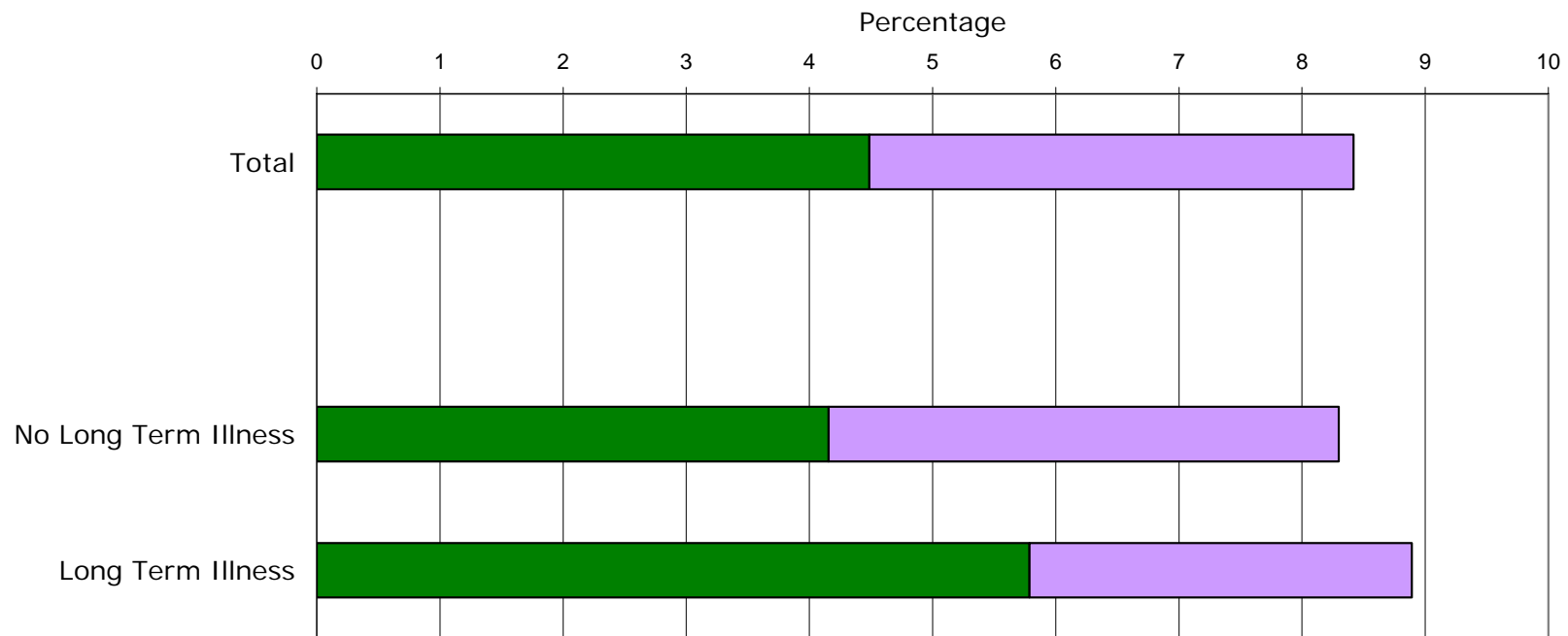


### P8 Limiting long-term illness percentage not as on form

For 4.5 percent of persons, a value of limiting long-term illness had to be imputed. Imputation was relatively more common for persons with a limiting long-term illness with a rate of 5.8 percent.

Conversely, person imputation was relatively more prevalent among those with no limiting long-term illness at 4.1 percent compared with an average for all persons of 3.9 percent.
