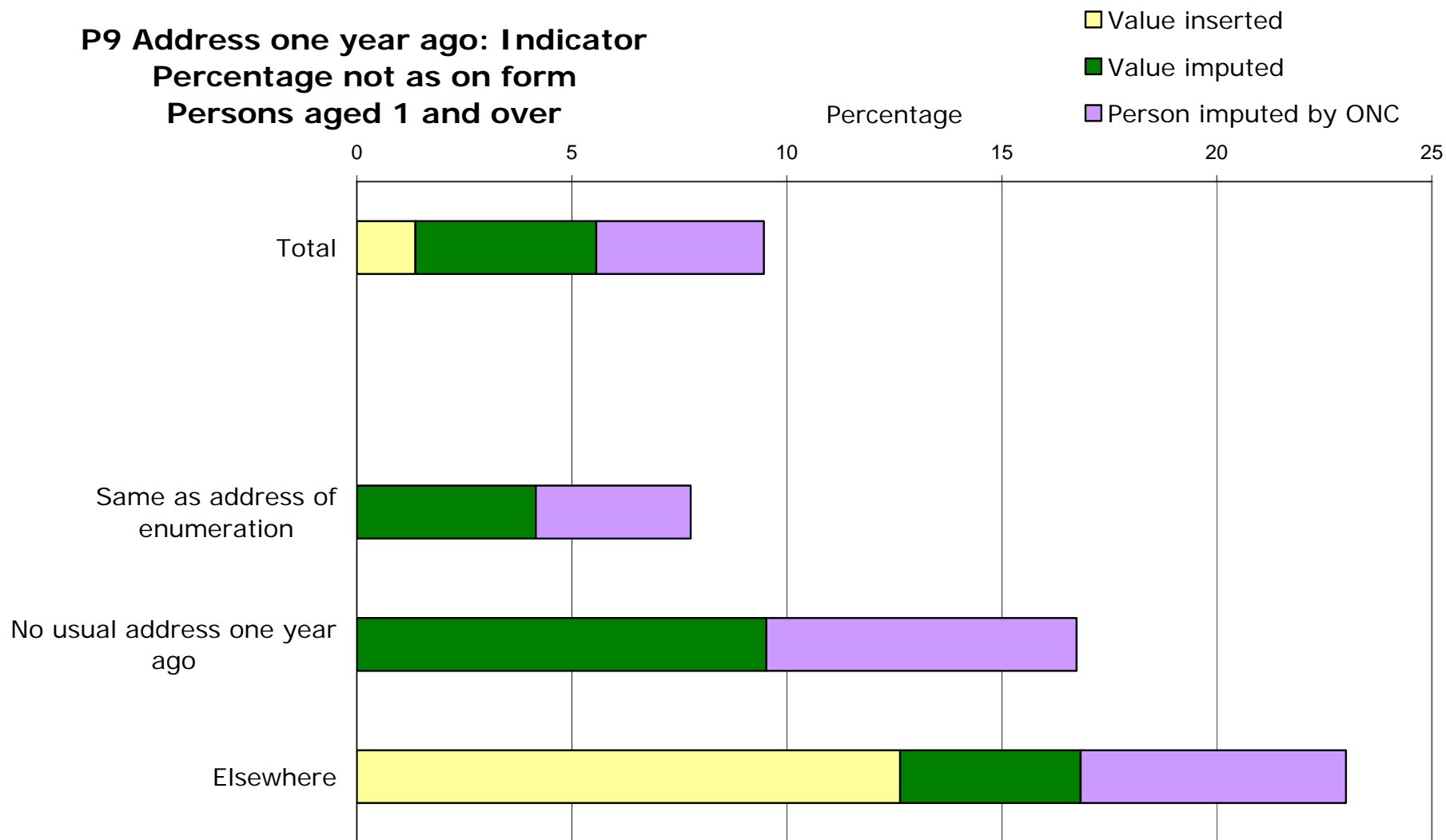

The analysis for this variable excludes persons aged under 1 because they were initially allocated to the category 'No usual address one year ago'. Later, for output, children aged under 1 in households would be assigned the migrant status of their next of kin.

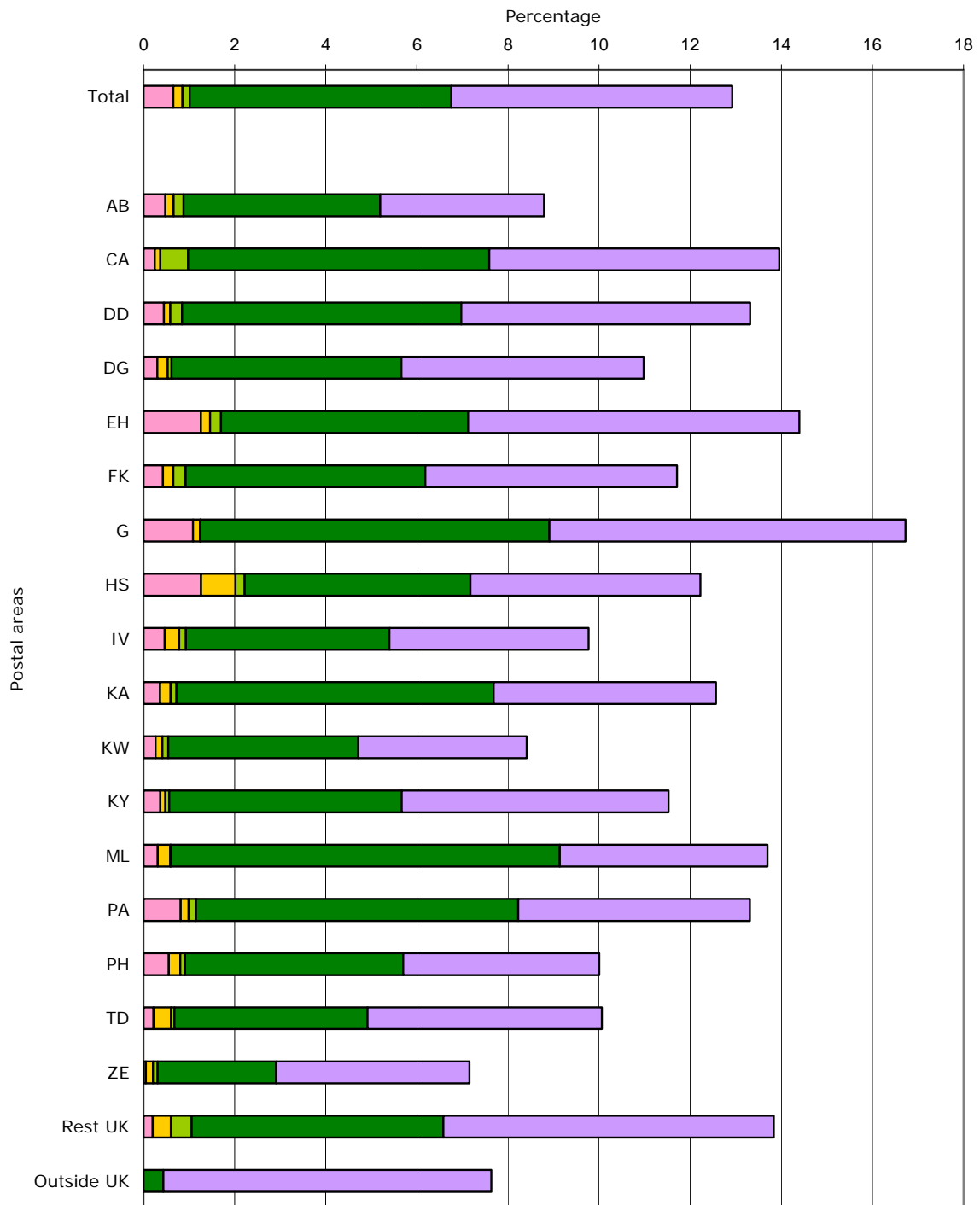
As part of the automatic editing of records, a value of 'Elsewhere' was inserted when no box had been ticked but there was a sufficient entry in the space for the previous address. 1.4 percent of persons aged 1 or over had a value inserted in this way, which was 12.4 percent of those with address one year ago 'Elsewhere'.

4.2 percent of persons aged 1 or over, had a value of migrant status indicator imputed. This rate for individual categories was much the same except for 'No usual address one year ago', which was more than double the average at 9.5 percent.

The same category also showed the highest rate of person imputation, at 7.2 percent compared with an average of 3.9 percent. Migrants with known previous addresses also had a relatively high rate of person imputation at 6.2 percent.

For the 539,278 persons aged 1 or over with Migrant status 'Elsewhere', 36,441 were enumerated persons with an origin (postcode within UK or country outside UK) imputed. Imputation used whatever partial postcode was supplied by the form-filler or determined by coders from the form-filler's entry. Of the 36,441 cases of origin imputed, 5,464 (15.0 percent of imputed origins, and 1.0 percent of all persons aged 1 or over with Migrant status 'Elsewhere'). These can be further broken down by the portion of the full postcode that was available. In 3,530 cases, the postcode sector was known (ie all but the last two letters of the code), in 1097 cases, the district (ie all before the space separating the two parts of the postcode), and in 837, the area (the letters at the start of the postcode).

In addition to cases where an origin was imputed, there are those where a person record has been added by the ONC process. These numbered 33,258 - 6.17 percent of all persons aged 1 or over with migrant status 'Elsewhere'.

Origins may be classified geographically in several ways. In this analysis, they are classified according to postcode area. The table shows the areas found in Scotland with those for the rest of the UK grouped into a single class, as are the countries of the rest of the world. An average of 0.7 percent of persons aged 1 or over with migrant status 'Elsewhere' had an origin imputed given a known postcode sector. The postcode areas with the highest rates of such imputation were EH and HS both with 1.3 percent. Origins were imputed with known postcode district in 0.2 percent of cases. HS was the postcode area with the highest rate of this type of imputation. Imputation with known postcode area averaged 0.2 percent with a high of 0.6 in CA.

The whole postcode (or country) was imputed in 5.7 percent of cases with highs of over 7 percent for the ML, G and PA postcode areas.

A person aged over 1 with migrant status 'Elsewhere' was imputed in 6.2 cases on average. Rates for postcode area varied from below 4 percent (AB and KW) to over 7 (EH, G and the rest of the UK). Over 7 percent of persons with origins outside the UK were added by the ONC process.
