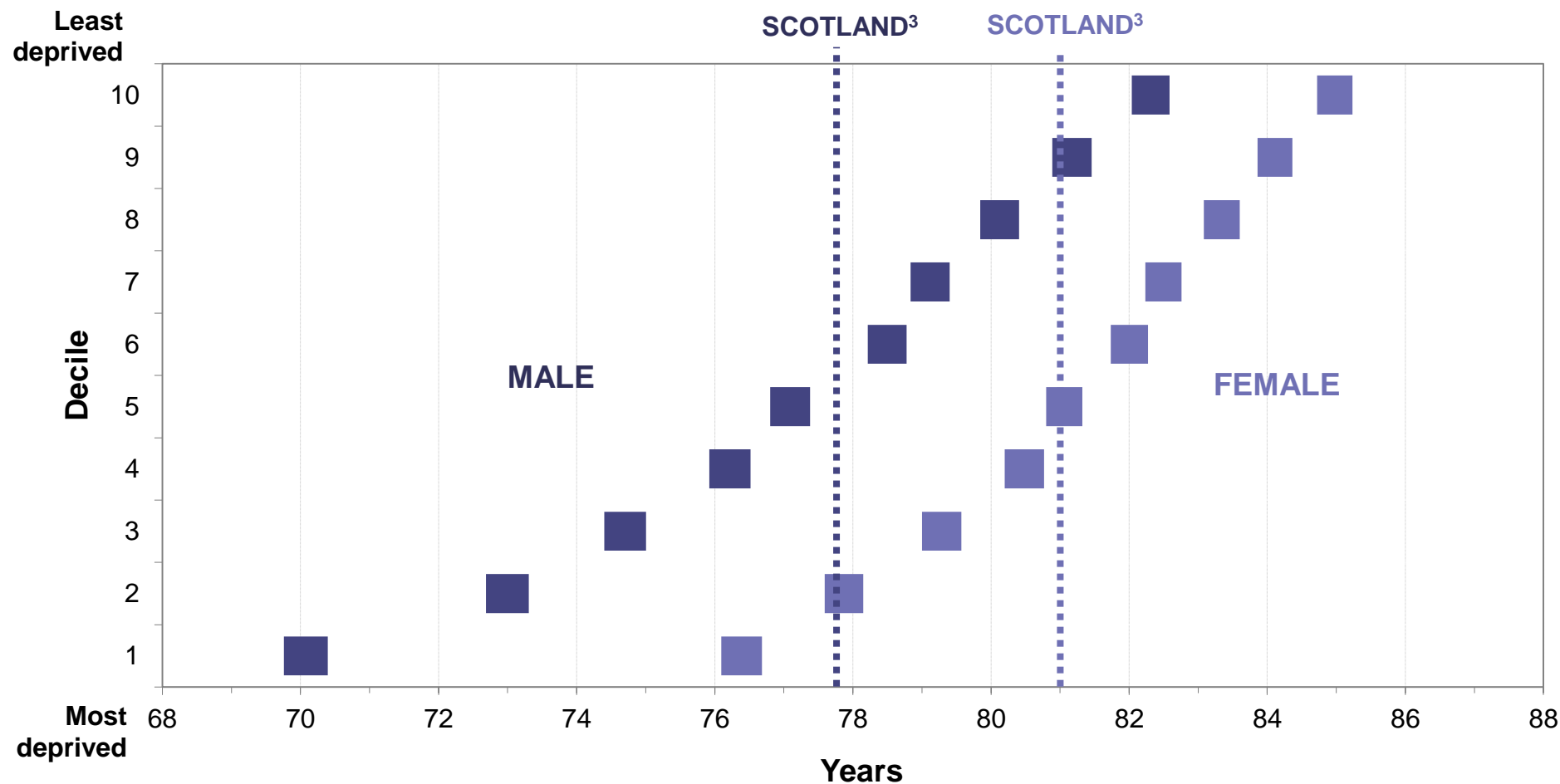


Figure 4.6: Life expectancy at birth by level of deprivation² with 95% confidence intervals (CI)¹, 2013-2015³ (males and females)
