After consulting users of its demographic statistics in December 2010, NRS decided to postpone, for at least a few years, updating those estimates because other work has higher priority. Should more up-to-date marital status estimates be produced, then more up-to-date rates would be published in a subsequent edition of this table.

2) Rates for age groups 15-19 and 40-44 include births at age under 15 and over 44 respectively. The all ages rate includes cases where the mother's age was not stated and is calculated using the number of women aged 15-44.
